Monday, the 11th of December	9,00	Welcoming to school
	9,00-9,30	A guided tour of the school and after that, the host team presents, using PPT, short informations about school
	9,30-10,00	Getting-to-know games
	10,00-10,30	The host school team presents - using Glogster- the country and the city(Romania, Iassy)
	10,30-11,00	Coffe break
	11,00- 12,30	All students participating in the learning/teaching activity, grouped according to certain criteria (in each team there are students from all the countries in the project) work in the computer laboratory to write a leaflet containing a language survival guide with terms/phrases in Romanian and in English. The phrases and terms should be chosen in advance by the host school and posted on the working group – to be familiarised with them.

	14,00-16,00	The students are organised into working groups (other groups than those of earlier) and they create ornaments from recyclable materials for the Christmas tree and table decorations. The ornaments made by the students will be evaluated by a jury of teachers: one teacher from each country in the project.

Tuesday, the 12th of December	9,30-12,30	Workshop at the Palace of Culture at the Ethnographic Museum: students, divided into teams, will be coordinated by craftsmen and will experience the hand stitching art of traditional motifs that are found on folk costumes and the art of making traditional masks.
	12,30-13,30	Lunch – Palas Mall
	13,30-16,00	A festival of cultures (each country presents specific customs and traditions for the event - winter celebrations), including culinary traditions; the team from Romania will present an artistic programme with Christmas carols, wishes for the New Year, the bear's dance, the goat's dance, Sorcova –making wishing using a branch or a stick adorned with artificial flowers;

Wednesday, the 13th of December

A research visit for one day in Bucovina, a typical region for the Romanian traditions and customs as well as for specific dishes;

In order to find out these traditions there will be organised visits to the Village Museum in Suceava, to old traditional Inns (Ancuței Inn and Drăgușeni Inn), to Voroneț Monastery - which is part of UNESCO world heritage sites. The participants will also visit traditional villages from Bucovina, will eat at a guesthouse in Bucovina where they can taste the traditional food and, most importantly, they will be able to see and learn details about the cooking methods in the past and at present.

The traditional dishes to be offered will be typical for the winter season and the atmosphere will be completed by an artistic programme that promotes winter customs and traditions (Christmas carols, the goat's dance, the bear's dance, the little plough, Sorcova - New Year's wishes).

Date	Schedule	Name of Activity
Thursday, the 14th of December	9,30-12,30	The practical activity will be organised – cooking – including the working space; Before the learning/teaching activity, each partner chooses and communicates to the host country what typical dish they will prepare, in this case for the event of winter celebrations. The school team in Romania purchases the raw materials needed for each country based on the lists sent in advance. In each team there will be 4 students who will prepare the dish and who belong to the same country and 1 or 2 students from the other countries in the project. The dishes prepared by the students will be evaluated by a jury of teachers: one teacher from each country in the project.
	12,30-13,00	At the end of the practical activity, a culinary exhibition of the students' dishes will be organised.
	13,00-13,30	The dishes prepared by the students will be evaluated by a jury of teachers: one teacher from each country in the project.
	13,30-14,00	The feedback of the activity will be provided as all the participants in the activity will complete a questionnaire.
	14,00-15,00	Lunch - traditional Romanian food.
