Monday, the 3rd of April	9.00-9.30	School Presentation The PPT presentation covers information related to school human resources and equipment, results achieved during curricular and extra-curricular activities, as well as main projects carried out.
	9.30-10.30	Country and City Presentation The presentation was made by using GlogsterEdu, containing the most relevant information about geographical location, relief, natural and heritage touristic attractions, and traditions of our region.

	13.00-14.00	<p>Lesson 1 – English Lesson</p> <p>All the students in the project will be involved in solving tasks during the lesson, in mixed groups (of all the countries of the project). During this lesson, they will have the opportunity of working in team, of using and even improving their English which is the language used in this project.</p>
	14.00-15.00	<p>Lesson 2 - ITC Lesson</p> <p>Subject: Build Apps Now!</p> <p>The lesson has as the main purpose promoting, in a funny and creative way, the most elementary concepts of programming. This approach will lead to raising the awareness and confidence in the positive changes resulted from learning new concepts of computer technology. The participants will create simple game-type applications for mobile phones, starting from https://bitsbox.com/hoc2016.html#find-songs address.</p>
	15.30 – 16.30	<p>Visit at the City Hall</p> <p>All the participants in the project, teachers and students, will have the opportunity of visiting Iasi City Hall, and finding out cultural and historical information about the Roznovanu Palace. There will be a guide working at the City Hall.</p>

Visit for documentation around Iași and in Neamț County in which the students involved in the project will be able to find out cultural, historical and geographical information, and take pictures that will be useful to them in making glogs, as well as videos which will summarize their activity throughout the week (being in perfect concordance with the main purpose of the project – that of using web 2.0 instruments for developing ITC skills among the students).

Wednesday, the 5th of April	9.00-13.00	<p>Treasure Hunt interurban game</p> <p>The students will be organised into 3 teams of 15 persons each. 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		<p>Visit to the Ethnographic Museum</p> <p>The students and the teachers from the partner countries will have the opportunity, by visiting the Palace of Culture, to find out information in detail about the Romanian traditions, and to admire old and new traditional costumes from different areas of the country. Thus, they will acquire knowledge about the Romanian traditions and values.</p>
	14.00-15.30	Lunch Break – in the centre of the city
	15.30-17.30	<p>Workshop – Easter Egg Painting</p> <p>With the help of some craftsmen from Iasi county, the students will learn the Easter egg painting technique, which is mostly specific to Bukovina county. Thus, they will acquire knowledge about the Romanian traditions and values.</p> <p>This workshop finds its utility and attractiveness especially as Easter is coming.</p>
